

HUBUNGAN MOTIVASI PERAWAT DENGAN KELENGKAPAN DOKUMENTASI *EARLY WARNING SCORE* DI RUANGAN RAWAT INAP KELAS III RSUD SUMEDANG

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ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang: *Cardiac Arrest* merupakan penyebab utama kematian nomor 1 di dunia berkisar 300.000-350.000 kejadian di Indonesia. Untuk mencegah hal tersebut terdapat sistem deteksi dini yang dikenal dengan *Early Warning Score*. Salah satu faktor yang mempengaruhi kelengkapan dokumentasi yaitu keberadaan motivasi, hal ini menunjukkan bahwa semakin tinggi motivasi maka semakin tinggi juga kelengkapan dokumentasi. **Tujuan Penelitian:** Menganalisis hubungan motivasi perawat dengan kelengkapan dokumentasi *early warning score* di ruangan rawat inap kelas III RSUD Sumedang. **Metode Penelitian:** deskriptif korelasi dengan pendekatan cross-sectional, populasi sebanyak 124 perawat, sampel 55 perawat. Teknik pengambilan sampel yaitu *purposive sampling* dengan menggunakan kuesioner yang sudah diuji oleh dosen pakar keperawatan Universitas Bhakti Kencana, data di analisis dengan menggunakan analisa univariat dan bivariat. **Hasil Penelitian:** Hasil penelitian didapatkan hasil perawat memiliki motivasi sedang (61.8%), dan lebih dari setengah perawat tidak melakukan dokumentasi *ews* secara lengkap (50.9%), terdapat hubungan dengan nilai Sig. 0.041. Pada penelitian ini perawat memiliki motivasi sedang dibuktikan bahwa motivasi merupakan dasar utama yang harus dimiliki oleh setiap perawat demi mencapai tujuan yang diharapkan. **Saran:** bagi peneliti selanjutnya dapat memakai teknik total sampling agar sampel yang dihasilkan lebih banyak serta melakukan penelitian di setiap ruangan rawat inap.

**RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN NURSES' MOTIVATION AND THE
COMPLETENESS OF EARLY WARNING SCORE
DOCUMENTATION IN CLASS III INPATIENT
ROOM OF SUMEDANG REGIONAL HOSPITAL**

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ABSTRACT

Background: Cardiac Arrest is the number 1 leading cause of death in the world, ranging from 300,000-350,000 incidents in Indonesia. To prevent this, there is an early detection system known as Early Warning Score. One of the factors that influences the completeness of documentation is the existence of motivation, this shows that the higher the motivation, the higher the completeness of the documentation. **Research Objective:** To analyze the relationship between nurses' motivation and the completeness of early warning score documentation in class III inpatient rooms of Sumedang Regional Hospital. **Research Method:** descriptive correlation with cross-sectional approach, population of 124 nurses, sample of 55 nurses. The sampling technique is purposive sampling using a questionnaire that has been tested by a nursing expert lecturer at Bhakti Kencana University, the data was analyzed using univariate and bivariate analysis. **Research Results:** The results of the study showed that nurses had moderate motivation (61.8%), and more than half of the nurses did not do complete EWS documentation (50.9%), there was a relationship with the Sig. value. 0.041. In this study, nurses had moderate motivation, it was proven that motivation is the main basis that every nurse must have in order to achieve the expected goals. **Suggestion:** for further researchers, they can use the total sampling technique so that the resulting sample is larger and conduct research in each inpatient room.
