

ABSTRAK

Pandemi Covid-19 menjadi permasalahan serius di dunia dengan jumlah kasus yang selalu meningkat setiap harinya. Pemerintah melakukan berbagai upaya untuk memutus rantai penyebaran covid-19 dengan pemberian vaksinasi. Banyaknya berita *hoax* yang beredar tentang bahaya vaksinasi dan Kejadian Ikutan Pasca Imunisasi (KIPI) covid-19 menimbulkan kecemasan pada masyarakat. Tujuan penelitian ini yaitu untuk mengetahui hubungan pengetahuan masyarakat dengan kecemasan terhadap Kejadian Ikutan Pasca Imunisasi (KIPI) covid-19 di Desa Suradita RW 03 Kecamatan Cisauk Kabupaten Tangerang.

Metode penelitian berupa penelitian korelasional dengan pendekatan *cross sectional*. Populasi dalam penelitian ini yaitu masyarakat yang belum melakukan vaksinasi sebanyak 163 orang dan sampel 115 orang dengan teknik pengambilan sampel yaitu *stratified random sampling*. Pengumpulan data dilakukan dengan cara pemberian kuesioner kepada responden. Analisis data yang digunakan menggunakan analisis univariat dan bivariat dengan uji *rank spearman*.

Hasil penelitian didapatkan bahwa tingkat pengetahuan masyarakat mengenai Kejadian Ikutan Pasca Imunisasi (KIPI) Covid-19 seluruhnya berpengetahuan kurang sebanyak 115 orang, tingkat kecemasan masyarakat terhadap Kejadian Ikutan Pasca Imunisasi (KIPI) Covid-19 sebagian besar dengan cemas ringan sebanyak 91 orang, dan terdapat hubungan antara pengetahuan masyarakat dengan kecemasan terhadap Kejadian Ikutan Pasca Imunisasi (KIPI) covid-19 di Desa Suradita RW 03 Kecamatan Cisauk Kabupaten Tangerang dengan nilai $p\text{-value} = 0.009$.

Kesimpulan didapatkan bahwa terdapat hubungan antara pengetahuan dengan kecemasan terhadap Kejadian Ikutan Pasca Imunisasi (KIPI) Covid-19, untuk mengurangi kecemasan perlu dilakukan adanya peningkatan pengetahuan dengan cara pemberian edukasi berupa pendidikan kesehatan kepada masyarakat mengenai Kejadian Ikutan Pasca Imunisasi (KIPI) Covid-19.

ABSTRACT

The COVID-19 pandemic is a serious problem in the world with the number of cases increasing every day. The government has made various efforts to break the chain of the spread of COVID-19 by giving vaccinations. The number of hoax news circulating about the dangers of vaccination and Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) of covid-19 caused anxiety in the community. The purpose of this study was to determine the relationship between public knowledge and anxiety about Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) of covid-19 in Suradita Village, RW 03, Cisauk District, Tangerang Regency.

The research method is correlational research with a cross sectional approach. The population in this study were 163 people who had not vaccinated and a sample of 115 people with the sampling technique of stratified random sampling. Data was collected by giving questionnaires to respondents. Data analysis used univariate and bivariate analysis with rank spearmen test.

The results of the study showed that the level of public knowledge regarding the Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) of Covid-19 was entirely lacking in knowledge of 115 people, the level of public anxiety about the Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) of Covid-19 was mostly with mild anxiety as many as 91 people, and there were 91 people with mild anxiety. the relationship between public knowledge and anxiety Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) of Covid-19 in Suradita Village RW 03, Cisauk District, Tangerang Regency with a p-value = 0.009.

The conclusion was that there was a relationship between knowledge and anxiety about the Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) of Covid-19 , to reduce anxiety it was necessary to increase knowledge by providing education in the form of health education to the public regarding the Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) of Covid-19.
