

KEPATUHAN PENATA ANESTESI DALAM PELAKSANAAN ASSESMEN PRE ANESTESI SESUAI STANDAR DI RUMAH SAKIT UMUM DAERAH CIAMIS

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ABSTRAK

Pelaksanaan assesmen pre anestesi ialah langkah penting dalam menjamin keselamatan pasien sebelum tindakan pembedahan. Kepatuhan penata anestesi dalam melaksanakan assesmen sesuai standar pelayanan Permenkes no.18 tahun 2016 yang telah ditetapkan sangat berpengaruh terhadap mutu pelayanan dan pencegahan resiko komplikasi anestesi. Untuk menganalisis kepatuhan penata anestesi dalam pelaksanaan assesmen anestesi sesuai standar di ruang pre-operasi RSUD Ciamis, serta faktor yang memengaruhi tingkat kepatuhan tersebut. Metode penelitian yang digunakan adalah deskriptif kuantitatif dengan pendekatan observasional. Pengambilan sampel yaitu total sampling yang digunakan pada penelitian ini yaitu 8 penata anestesi dalam pelaksanaan assesmen pre anestesi dengan melakukan observasi 87 pasien. Instrumen yang digunakan yaitu lembar observasi. Analisis data dalam penelitian ini menggunakan uji T-score. Hasil dari penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa tingkat kepatuhan penata anestesi tentang pelaksanaan assesmen pre anestesi di RSUD Ciamis rata-rata masuk dalam kategori sangat patuh, dimana terdapat 6 responden (75%) termaksud dalam kategori sangat patuh, sebanyak 1 orang penata anestesi termaksud kategori patuh (12,5%), dan sebanyak 1 orang penata anestesi (12,5%) termasuk dalam kategori cukup patuh. Kesimpulan: dapat diketahui bahwa sebagian besar proporsi kegiatan assesmen pre anestesi dilaksanakan oleh penata anestesi di IBS RSUD Ciamis berada pada kategori tidak patuh sebanyak 2 orang pasien (2,3%), pada kategori cukup patuh sebanyak 3 orang pasien (3,4%), sedangkan kategori patuh sebanyak 15 orang pasien (17,0%), dan sangat patuh sebanyak 67 orang pasien (76,1%).

**ANESTHESIA TEACHER COMPLIANCE IN
IMPLEMENTING PRE-ANESTHESIA ASSESSMENT
ACCORDING TO STANDARDS AT CIAMIS REGIONAL
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ABSTRACT

The implementation of pre-anesthesia assessment is a crucial step in ensuring patient safety before surgery. The compliance of anesthesiologists in carrying out assessments according to the service standards stipulated in Minister of Health Regulation No. 18 of 2016 significantly impacts the quality of service and the prevention of the risk of anesthetic complications. This study aims to analyze the compliance of anesthesiologists in carrying out anesthesia assessments according to standards in the pre-operative room of Ciamis Regional Hospital, as well as the factors influencing this level of compliance. The research method used is a quantitative descriptive approach with an observational approach. The sample used in this study were 8 anesthesiologists respondents to patients. The instrument used was an observation sheet. Data analysis in this study used the T-score test. Code of ethics number 110/09.KEPK/UBK/IV/2025. The results of this study indicate that the level of compliance of anesthesiologists regarding the implementation of pre-anesthesia assessment at Ciamis Regional General Hospital is on average in the very compliant category, where there are 6 respondents (75%) included in the very compliant category, as many as 1 anesthesiologist included in the compliant category (12.5%), and as many as 1 anesthesiologist (12.5%) included in the fairly compliant category. Conclusion: it can be seen that most of the proportion of pre-anesthesia assessment activities carried out by anesthesiologists at IBS Ciamis Regional General Hospital are in the non-compliant category as many as 2 patients (2.3%), in the fairly compliant category as many as 3 patients (3.4%), while the compliant category as many as 15 patients (17.0%), and very compliant as many as 67 patients (76.1%).
