

PENGELOLAAN OBAT LASA DI INSTALASI FARMASI RAWAT INAP DI RS SWASTA BANDUNG

ABSTRAK

Obat golongan LASA (*Look A Like Sound A Like*) adalah obat-obat yang perlu diwaspadai dalam pengelolaannya, baik dalam hal penyimpanan maupun penandaannya. Hal ini disebabkan karena kerena jika terjadi kesalahan dalam penggunaan maka dapat menyebabkan cedera serius pada pasien. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui kesesuaian penyimpanan dan penandaan obat LASA di Instalasi Farmasi Rawat Inap RS Swasta di Kota Bandung dengan Standar Prosedur Operasional (SPO). Metode yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah melalui kuesioner yang dibagikan kepada tenaga farmasi RS Swasta di Bandung. Hasil penelitian ini, menunjukkan bahwa ada 18,74% obat golongan LASA di farmasi rawat inap. Penyimpanan dan panandaan obat golongan LASA di instalasi rawat inap telah sesuai dengan standar prosedur operasional penyimpanan dan penandaan obat LASA.

Berdasarkan hal tersebut, dapat disimpulkan bahwa ada jenis obat LASA yang sering diresepkan dokter di instalasi rawat inap masing-masing 3 item berdasarkan kelompok barang yaitu *High Alert*, cream dan salep, tablet paten, narkotik, sirup, suhu kulkas, tablet generic, injeksi paten dan injeksi generic

ABSTRACT

LASA drugs (Look A Like Sound A Like) are drugs that need to be aware of in their management, both in terms of storage and marking. This is because because if there is an error in use it can cause serious injury to the patient. This study aims to determine the suitability of storage and marking of LASA drugs in Private Hospital Inpatient Pharmacy Installation in Bandung with Standard Operating Procedures (SPO). The method used in this study was through a questionnaire that was distributed to pharmacy hospital staff in Bandung. The results of this study, showed that there were 18.74% of LASA-class drugs in inpatient pharmacy. The storage and labeling of LASA class drugs in inpatients is in accordance with the standard operating procedures for storing and marking LASA drugs.

Based on this, it can be concluded that there are types of LASA drugs that are often prescribed by doctors in inpatient installations each of 3 items based on item groups namely High Alert, creams and ointments, patent tablets, narcotics, syrups, refrigerator temperatures, generic tablets, patent injections and generic injection.
