

ABSTRAK

Pengkajian resep merupakan tindakan yang sangat penting dalam peresepan karena dapat membantu mengurangi terjadinya *medication error*. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui kesesuaian penulisan resep antihipertensi di Apotek Mitra Farma dengan cara melakukan pengkajian terhadap aspek administrasi dan farmasetik. Jenis penelitian ini bersifat deskriptif observasional. Pengambilan data dilakukan dengan cara retrospektif sebanyak 113 resep dari bulan Desember 2021- Februari 2022 di Apotek Mitra Farma Tasikmalaya. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa kelengkapan resep secara administrasi yakni meliputi nama pasien (100%), umur pasien (0%), berat badan (0%), jenis kelamin (100%) tinggi badan pasien (0%), nama dokter (100%), SIP dokter (10,62%), no telepon (100%), alamat (100%), paraf (100%) dan tanggal resep (100%). Farmasetik berupa Nama Sediaan (100%), Bentuk Sediaan (0%), Kekuatan sediaan (53,10%), stabilitas obat (100%), dan kompatibilitas (12,39%). Berdasarkan hasil penelitian maka dapat disimpulkan bahwa resep yang dikaji di Apotek Mitra Farma Tasikmalaya terdapat ketidaklengkapan resep berdasarkan Peraturan Menteri Kesehatan No. 73 tahun 2016 tentang Standar Pelayanan Kefarmasian di Apotek.

ABSTRACT

Prescription review is a very important action in prescribing because it can help reduce the occurrence of medication errors. This study aims to determine the suitability of writing antihypertensive prescriptions at the Mitra Farma Pharmacy by conducting an assessment of the administrative and pharmaceutical aspects. This type of research is descriptive observational. Data collection was carried out retrospectively as many as 113 prescriptions from December 2021-February 2022 at the Mitra Farma Pharmacy Tasikmalaya. The results showed that the administrative completeness of the prescription included the patient's name (100%), patient's age (0%), weight (0%), gender (100%) patient's height (0%), doctor's name (100%), doctor's SIP (10.62%), telephone number (100%), address (100%), initials (100%) and date of prescription (100%). Pharmaceuticals in the form of dosage name (100%), dosage form (0%), strength of dosage (53.10%), drug stability (100%), and compatibility (12.39%). Based on the results of the study, it can be concluded that the prescriptions studied at the Mitra Farma Tasikmalaya Pharmacy have incomplete prescriptions based on the Regulation of the Minister of Health no. 73 of 2016 concerning Pharmaceutical Service Standards in Pharmacies.
