

## ABSTRAK

Pemilahan, pengumpulan, penampungan sementara, pengangkutan serta pemusnahan limbah medis merupakan kunci untuk melaksanakan pengelolaan limbah medis. Selain itu, pengelolaan yang dilakukan belum memenuhi persyaratan sistem pengelolaan limbah dan dilaksanakan sesuai dengan aturan yang berlaku di Puskesmas tersebut. Metode *literature review* yang digunakan adalah *literature review* dengan pendekatan kualitatif meta-sintesis. Jumlah artikel penelitian yang dianalisis sebanyak 7 artikel. Hasil *literature review* ini menunjukkan pengelolaan limbah medis Puskesmas terdapat kendala, yaitu terkadang terjadi penumpukan limbah, peran petugas belum dilaksanakan sesuai dengan tugas dan fungsi pokok masing-masing sehingga masih terdapat adanya limbah yang belum tertangani secara serius dan pengelolaan limbah medis di Puskesmas masih belum bisa disebut sempurna dikarenakan belum lengkapnya sarana dan prasarana yang ada. Hasil *Literature Review* menunjukkan beberapa artikel analisis pengolahan limbah medis belum sesuai dengan dengan Kepmenkes No.1428/Menkes/SK/XII/2006. Disarankan pemerintah mengadakannya pelatihan pengolahan limbah medis padat sesuai dengan peraturan yang ada dan penyediaan pendanaan yang cukup dan fasilitas pendukung untuk mempermudah tenaga medis dan petugas dalam pengolahan limbah medis padat.

## **ABSTRACT**

*Sorting, collecting, temporary collecting, transporting and destroying medical waste is the key to carrying out medical waste management. In addition, the management carried out does not meet the requirements of the waste management system and is carried out in accordance with the rules in force at the Puskesmas. The literature review method used is a literature review with a qualitative meta-synthesis approach. The number of research articles analyzed was 7 articles. The results of this literature review show that there is an obstacle in managing medical waste at the Puskesmas. Sometimes, there is accumulation of waste, the role of the officers has not been carried out in accordance with their respective duties and main functions so that there are still wastes that have not been handled seriously and the management of medical waste at the Puskesmas called perfect because of incomplete existing facilities and infrastructure. Literature Review results show that several articles on the analysis of medical waste processing are not in accordance with the Minister of Health Decree No.1428 / Menkes / SK / XII / 2006. It is recommended that the government arrange for training on solid medical waste treatment in accordance with existing regulations and the provision of adequate funding and supporting facilities to medical personnel and officers in processing solid medical waste.*
