

ABSTRACT

The problem of covid-19 disease is a health problem that is still not resolved. More than 177 million people, from the world's population, are infected with covid-19 due to direct human-to-human contact through close contact and droplets. This research aims to find out the intrinsic motivation of students of DIII Nursing University Bhakti Kencana Bandung about the prevention of covid-19 transmission. Coronavirus or severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) is a virus that attacks the respiratory system. The disease due to this viral infection is called COVID-19. This study uses descriptive methods. The population in this study was 321 students with proportionate stratified random sampling techniques. That's a sample of 77 respondents. Data collection techniques using questionnaires. Using a motivational scale the score <50% low motivation >50% high motivation. The results showed that most respondents had intrinsic motivation based on high interest in preventing covid-19 transmission as many as 58 people (75%) had intrinsic motivation based on high attitudes as many as 60 people (78%) had intrinsic motivation based on high needs as many as 61 people (79%). For Bhakti Kencana University Bandung is expected to encourage its students to further improve their health protocols because there are still some who have low motivation.
