Kepatuhan Pemberian *Informed Consent* oleh Penata Anestesi Kepada Pasien yang Akan Menjalani Operasi di RSUD Kota Bandung

Dalam tindakan medis perlu adanya persetujuan atau *Informed Consent* tindakan antara tenaga kesehatan dan pasien. Salah satunya adalah tindakan anestesi, *Informed consent* perlu diberikan kepada pasien atau keluarga pasien agar tindakan yang diberikan dapat dimengerti baik dari prosedur tindakan sampai ke resiko tindakan. Dalam penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui kepatuhan penata anestesi dalam memberikan *Informed Consent* anestesi yang akan menjalani operasi dengan anestesi umum dan anestesi spinal. Metode dalam penelitian ini yaitu penelitian deskriptif kuantitatif dengan menggunakan pendekatan study observasional. Pengambilan sampel dalam penelitian ini dengan responden seluruh pasien yang akan menjalani operasi dengan anestesi umum dan anestesi spinal dengan melihat penata anestesi melakukan *Informed Consent* kepada pasien. Instrumen penelitian yang digunakan lembar observasi yang diadopsi dari SOP *Informed Consent* rumah sakit. Hasil dari penelitian ini berjumlah 71 responden, frekuensi anestesi umum dengan kategori patuh ada sebanyak 50 responden dengan presentase 92% dan yang tidak patuh sebanyak 4 responden dengan presentase 8%. *Informed consent* pada anestesi spinal menunjukkan kepatuhan pada penata anestesi dalam melakukan *informed consnet* sebanyak 17 responden dengan presentase 100%. Hasil penelitian ini diharapkan agar dapat meningkatkan kualitas kinerja sehingga perlu dipertahankan kepatuhan pelaksanaan pemberian *Informed Consent* oleh Penata Anestesi.

ABSTRACT

Compliance with Giving Informed Consent by Anesthesia Practitioners to Patients Who Will Undergo Surgery at Bandung City Regional Hospital

In medical procedures, there needs to be Informed Consent between the health worker and the patient. One of them is anesthesia. Informed consent needs to be given to the patient or the patient's family so that the procedure given can be understood, from the procedure to the risks of the procedure. This study aims to determine the compliance of anesthetists in providing Informed Consent for anesthetists who will undergo surgery under general anesthesia and spinal anesthesia. The method in this research is quantitative descriptive research using an observational study approach. Samples were taken in this study with respondents from all patients who were going to undergo surgery with general anesthesia and spinal anesthesia by observing the anesthetist providing Informed Consent to the patient. The research instrument used was an observation sheet adopted from the hospital's Informed Consent SOP. The results of this study amounted to 71 respondents, the frequency of general anesthesia in the compliant category was 50 respondents with a percentage of 92% and those who did not comply were 4 respondents with a percentage of 8%. Informed consent in spinal anesthesia shows the compliance of the anesthetist in carrying out Informed Consent by 17 respondents with a percentage of 100%. It is hoped that the results of this research will improve the quality of performance so that it is necessary to maintain compliance with the implementation of Informed Consent by Anesthesia Practitioners.
