

GAMBARAN PERSEPSI MASYARAKAT TERHADAP TUGAS PENATA ANESTESI DI DESA MEKAR AYU PROVINSI NANGGROE ACEH DARUSSALAM

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ABSTRAK

Pelayanan anestesi menjadi salah satu bagian dari pelayanan kesehatan yang berkembang cepat seiring dengan peningkatan ilmu pengetahuan dan teknologi di bidang anestesi. Tujuan dalam penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui gambaran persepsi masyarakat terhadap tugas penata anestesi. Metode penelitian yang digunakan adalah penelitian deskriptif kuantitatif dengan pendekatan analisis. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah masyarakat Desa Mekar Ayu yang sudah pernah menjalani tindakan anestesi/pernah di operasi di Rumah Sakit yang berjumlah 1.450 jiwa. Sampel penelitian ini yaitu responden yang memenuhi kriteria inklusi dan dihitung menggunakan rumus, (jika populasi (N) diketahui), sampel yang di ambil berjumlah 77 responden. Penelitian ini menggunakan teknik *Non probability sampling* dengan teknik *purposive sampling*. Instrumen penelitian menggunakan kuisioner google form. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa persepsi masyarakat terhadap petugas penata anestesi sebagian besar berkategori cukup yaitu sebanyak 57 orang (74.0%), persepsi masyarakat berdasarkan respon didapatkan sebagian besar cukup yaitu sebanyak 54 orang (70.1%), Persepsi masyarakat berdasarkan pemahaman diperoleh sebagian besar dalam kategori cukup yaitu sebanyak 35 orang (45.5%), Persepsi masyarakat berdasarkan penilaian diperoleh sebagian besar dalam kategori cukup yaitu sebanyak 42 orang (54.5%). Saran dari peneliti harapannya, organisasi profesi IPAI dapat melakukan kegiatan bakti sosial misalnya terkait pembiusan pada bibir sumbing, sehingga masyarakat dapat membuka diri dalam mengikuti bakti sosial atau kegiatan kemasyarakatan mengenai kegiatan seperti operasi bibir sumbing, sehingga masyarakat dapat lebih sering bertemu langsung dengan penata anestesi. Maka masyarakat terbiasa dalam membentuk persepsi.

DESCRIPTION OF COMMUNITY PERCEPTIONS OF THE DUTIES OF NURSE ANAESTHETISTS IN MEKAR AYU VILLAGE, NANGGROE ACEH DARUSSALAM PROVINCE

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ABSTRACT

Anaesthesia services are one part of health services that are growing rapidly along with the improvement of science and technology in the field of anaesthesia. The purpose of this study was to determine the description of public perceptions of the duties of nurse anaesthetists. The research method used was quantitative descriptive research with an analytical approach. The population in this study was the people of Mekar Ayu Village who had undergone anaesthesia or had been underwent surgery which amounted to 1,450 people. The sample of this study were respondents who met the inclusion criteria and were calculated using the formula, (if the population (N) is known), the sample taken was 77 respondents. This study uses Non probability sampling technique with purposive sampling technique. The research instrument used a google form questionnaire. The results showed that the public's perception of anaesthesia staff was mostly in the moderate category, namely 57 people (74.0%), public perception based on the response was mostly sufficient, namely 54 people (70.1%), public perception based on understanding was mostly in the moderate category, namely 35 people (45.5%), public perception based on assessment was mostly in the moderate category, namely 42 people (54.5%). Suggestions from researchers hope that the IPAI professional organisation can carry out social service activities, for example related to anesthesia on cleft lip, so that the community can open up in participating in social services or community activities regarding activities such as cleft lip surgery, so that people can meet directly with anesthetists more often. Then the community is accustomed to forming perceptions.
