

**PENILAIAN INDIKATOR MUTU PENYIMPANAN OBAT
DI BEBERAPA PUSKESMAS KOTA DAN KABUPATEN
BANDUNG**

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ABSTRAK

Ketidakefisienan dalam penyimpanan obat di puskesmas, dapat mengakibatkan ketersediaan obat yang tidak optimal dan penurunan mutu pengobatan. Penelitian ini bertujuan mengetahui penyimpanan obat di beberapa Puskesmas Kota dan Kabupaten Bandung menggunakan indikator penyimpanan obat Delphi termodifikasi. Penelitian dilakukan melalui studi observasional yang bersifat deskriptif kuantitatif dengan pendekatan *cross sectional*. Hasil penelitian di empat puskesmas sudah sesuai standar, terutama dalam penyimpanan berdasarkan bentuk sediaan dan penerapan metode *First Expire First Out* (FEFO). Namun, terdapat kekurangan pada penyimpanan suhu, obat psikotropik, obat-obat tertentu (OOT), serta penanganan obat *high-alert* dan *look-alike sound-alike* (LASA). Ditemukan juga kontaminan makanan dan minuman di lemari pendingin serta obat tanpa kemasan primer. Pengelolaan penyimpanan obat sudah sesuai standar namun perlu peningkatan untuk memenuhi standar pelayanan kesehatan secara optimal.

***ASSESSMENT OF DRUG STORAGE QUALITY INDICATORS
IN SEVERAL HEALTH CENTERS IN BANDUNG CITY AND
REGENCY***

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ABSTRACT

Inefficiencies in drug storage in health centers can lead to suboptimal drug availability and decreased quality of treatment. This study aims to determine drug storage in several Bandung City and Regency Health Centers using modified Delphi drug storage indicators. The research was conducted through an observational study that was descriptive quantitative with a cross sectional approach. The results of the study in four health centers were in accordance with standards, especially in storage based on dosage forms and the application of the First Expire First Out (FEFO) method. However, there were deficiencies in temperature storage, psychotropic drugs, certain drugs (OOT), and handling of high-alert and look-alike sound-alike (LASA) drugs. Food and beverage contaminants in refrigerators and drugs without primary packaging were also found. The management of drug storage is in accordance with standards but needs improvement to meet optimal health service standards.
